

How to access an epub file

For Android

1. **Download an EPUB Reader App:** Android doesn't come with a built-in EPUB reader, so you'll need an app. Some popular choices include:
 - **Google Play Books:** You can upload the EPUB file to Google Play Books and read it there.
 - **Lithium:** A lightweight and easy-to-use EPUB reader.
 - **Moon+ Reader:** A more customizable reading experience.
2. **Open the EPUB File:** Once the app is installed, open the EPUB file directly by tapping it (it should automatically open with your chosen app). Alternatively, upload the file from within the app if that's required.

For iPhone

1. **Use Apple Books:** Apple's Books app natively supports EPUB files.

 - You can also add it by opening the Books app, tapping "Library," and choosing "Import."
2. **Alternative Apps:** If you prefer another reading app, there are many options in the App Store like:

 - **Bluefire Reader:** Known for compatibility and easy navigation.
